CAMP LOCATIONS

WEST LA -EMERSON MIDDLE SCHOOL

1650 Selby Ave., Los Angeles, CA 90024. Please drop off at the front of the school and follow signs to the gym.

WOODLAND HILLS - TAFT HIGH SCHOOL

5461 Winnetka Ave, Woodland Hills, CA 91364. Please enter the parking lot off of Santa Rita St which is west of Winnetka Ave. and south of Ventura Blvd. Please follow signs to the gym.

SILVER LAKE - IVANHOE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

2828 Herkimer St., Los Angeles, CA 90039. Please park in front of the school and enter the auditorium.

SIGN IN AND SIGN OUT LOCATION

Sign in and sign out takes place inside the Gym or Auditorium (Silver Lake) each location. Morning and afternoon extended care are at the same location as well.

INFORMATION MEETING

The first 30 minutes of the first day of each session are utilized as a camper information meeting (parents are welcome). The children are introduced to the counselors, meet their groups, and learn about camp philosophies and rules.

EXTENDED CARE INFORMATION

Extended care is available from 8:00am to 6:00pm at West LA, Woodland Hills, Hancock Park and Silver Lake. Santa Monica is 8:30am to 5:30pm. The rate is \$2.50 per half hour, or any fraction thereof. Extended Care will be charged to your credit/debit card the day after it is used. All campers are placed in Extended Care at 3:35pm.

There is a 20 minute drop off/pick up grace period before and after camp; 8:40am - 9:00am and 3:30pm - 3:50pm. Any child dropped off before or picked up after the grace period will be charged for extended care.

T-SHIRTS

All campers receive a complimentary shirt. Extra shirts may be purchased for \$10. For safety reasons, campers must wear their shirt every day.

WHAT TO BRING

In addition to wearing a camp shirt, please make sure your child brings lunch if they are not purchasing one, a water bottle and lots of sunscreen. Sunscreen should be applied at home prior to camp. Sunscreen and water to refill bottles are available on site as well. Hats are a good idea. Prime Time Sports Camp provides all equipment needed to have an amazing time at camp. If you choose to send your camper with a baseball glove, please make sure his/her name is clearly visible.
